OPEN SESSION:

3. Discuss, consider, and take any necessary action to ratify a resolution proclaiming May 24, 2014, as Rev. Dr. Donald R. Madlock Sr., Day in Smith County.
4. Discuss, consider, and take any necessary action to adopt a resolution proclaiming June 6-7, 2014, as the Golden Anniversary of the Top Ladies of Distinction, Incorporated.
