Fee Schedule

- **Dog Adoption** **\$75**
(Health & Safety 828)
The shelter provides the adopter with a voucher for the rabies vaccination and the sterilization to be redeemed at the SNIPPET clinic. The adopting party is responsible for setting the appointment for sterilizing the dog as well as a rabies vaccination within 30 days of the adoption. While in the shelter, dogs receive their DAPP Vaccine, a Bordetella vaccination, a round of intestinal wormer, a capstar, a Parvo test under 6 months old, and is microchipped upon departed. (adoption, reclaim, or transfer to rescue)

- **Owner Reclaim Fee (Impound)**
(Health & Safety 826.033 c)
 - 1st Offense: **\$25 per canine**
 - 2nd Offense: **\$50 per canine**
 - 3rd Offense: **\$75 per canine**
 - 4th Offense: **\$100 per canine**

- **Animal Cruelty Housing**
(Ag. Code 142.010)
 - First Day **\$20 per canine**
 - Each day thereafter **\$15 per canine**

- **Microchip** **\$10**

- **Inspection of Dangerous Animal** **\$100**

(Health & Safety 822.103)

Inspection of facility/residence of where the dangerous animal resides

- **Dangerous Wild Animal Registration Fee** **\$20**
(Health & Safety 822.103 c)
For application, issuance, or renewal of certification of dangerous wild animal
- **Dangerous Dog** **\$100**
(Health & Safety 822.043)
Annual fee for the registration of a dangerous dog which includes a registration tag, inspection, signs, and certificate
- **Returned Checks** **\$30**
(LGC 118.141)
For checks paid to the county and returned by the bank
