**ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS COURT  
OF SMITH COUNTY, TEXAS  
SETTING POLICY  
FOR PARKING  
IN COUNTY FACILITIES  
PURSUANT TO TEX. GOV'T CODE § 615.001**

Pursuant to the Laws and Rules of the State of Texas, the Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 615, Section 615.001, and the common law granting the County authority to regulate the public health and safety, the Commissioners Court of Smith County finds that it is necessary to impose reasonable policies for parking in county facilities.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT** the following policies are adopted as set forth in Section 615.001:

- The use of parking spaces may be limited to certain vehicles or types of vehicle;
- The time that a vehicle may be parked in a specific space or area may be limited; and
- The parking of vehicles in certain areas may be prohibited.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** the Smith County Physical Plant shall place proper notice of prohibited parking to inform a driver of a vehicle of


the restriction or prohibition.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** that the county may provide for towing and storing a vehicle at the owner's expense if such vehicle is parked in violation of a rule adopted under this order, pursuant to Tex. Loc. Gov't Code § 615.001(d).


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** any person violating a rule adopted under this order commits an offense, which is a Class C misdemeanor, pursuant to Tex. Loc. Gov't Code § 615.001(e).






