**ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS COURT

SETTING POLICY  
FOR CLOSING  
T.B. BUTLER PLAZA SQUARE  
DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS**

Pursuant to the Laws and Rules of the State of Texas, the Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 291, Section 291.001, the Texas Health & Safety Code, Chapter 121, Section 121.003, and the common law granting the County authority to regulate the public health and safety, the Commissioners Court of Smith County finds that it is necessary to impose reasonable nighttime closing hours for T.B. Butler Plaza Square.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT** the nighttime closing hours for T.B. Butler Plaza Square shall be from 1:00 a.m. to 5:30 a.m.;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** the Smith County Physical Plant shall place notice of the closing hours under the direction of the Smith County Commissioners Court; and



criminal trespass laws of the City of Tyler and/or the State of Texas.




